Frequently Asked Questions

Q) What is single-stream recycling?

A) Single-Stream recycling is a recycling process in which recyclable materials are collected all together with no sorting required by individual recyclers. Now, you can recycle paper and cardboard WITH plastics, glass and metals.

Q) What happens to the single-stream recycling once its collected by Mass Hauling/Capital Paper Recycling?

A) Once the single-stream materials are collected by Mass Hauling/CPR, they are taken to their facility in Weymouth, MA where the recyclable materials are separated and bailed and sent to various markets for sale.

Q) What exactly can I put into my single-stream container?

- Newspapers/ Magazines
- Telephone/Soft Cover Books
- Junk Mail/Envelopes (all types)
- Paper
- Paperboard (cereal/tissue boxes)
- Cardboard
- Plastics (# 1-7 including grocery bags and #6 Styrofoam)
- Glass Bottles/Jars (any color)
- Metal Cans (tin/steel/aluminum)

Q) What goes into the trash?

A) Soiled paper/cardboard (greasy pizza boxes, tissues and napkins, etc), food waste, aerosol cans, broken glass, non-recyclable Styrofoam and wax paper.
